PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City of Whitefish is planning to reconstruct East 6th Street, from Spokane Avenue to Pine Avenue, with additional sidewalk upgrades along Pine Avenue from East 5th Street to East 6th Street. The reconstruction project will involve the design and construction of approximately 1,800 feet of roadway and path along East 6th Street and approximately 500 feet of new sidewalk along Pine Avenue from East 5th St to East 6th Street. The City has selected HDR Engineering, Inc. to complete the civil engineering and aid the City with project management, public involvement, design, and construction services. In addition to the roadway and path improvements, select utilities and drainages along the project corridor will also be improved along with decorative street lighting.

MEETING AGENDA

Two public meetings have previously been held to gain valuable input from residents in the project area and present preliminary design concepts. The City of Whitefish, in association with HDR Engineering, will host a third public meeting to provide residents with current project updates and schedule for completion, including a presentation of the final reconstruction design, in addition to receiving any additional input and answering any questions.
