



DISTRIBUTION OF HANDBILLS

§5-2-7 Whitefish City Code: Advertisements and Handbills:

B Handbills:

1. Definition “Handbill” means and includes any printed or written matter, any sample or device, dodger, circular, leaflet, pamphlet, paper, booklet, or any other printed or otherwise reproduced matter.

2. Prohibited Acts: It is unlawful for any person to distribute, deposit, place, throw, scatter or cast any handbill in any public place or on any private premises. However, it is not unlawful to:

- a. Distribute any handbill in any public or private place to any person willing to accept the same;

§1-4-1 Whitefish City Code: General Penalty:

Unless specifically provided elsewhere, any person prosecuted and found to have been in violation of any of the terms and provisions of this code or failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of the ordinances of the city, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500), payable to the city, or by imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that a violation continues shall be deemed to be a separate offense. (Ord. 09-20)
