What is Tax Increment Financing?



A method allowed by state law to reinvest the “increment” of new taxes from new development and increased property values back into a certain area of the city to eliminate blight, spur growth, and provide public infrastructure and facilities.

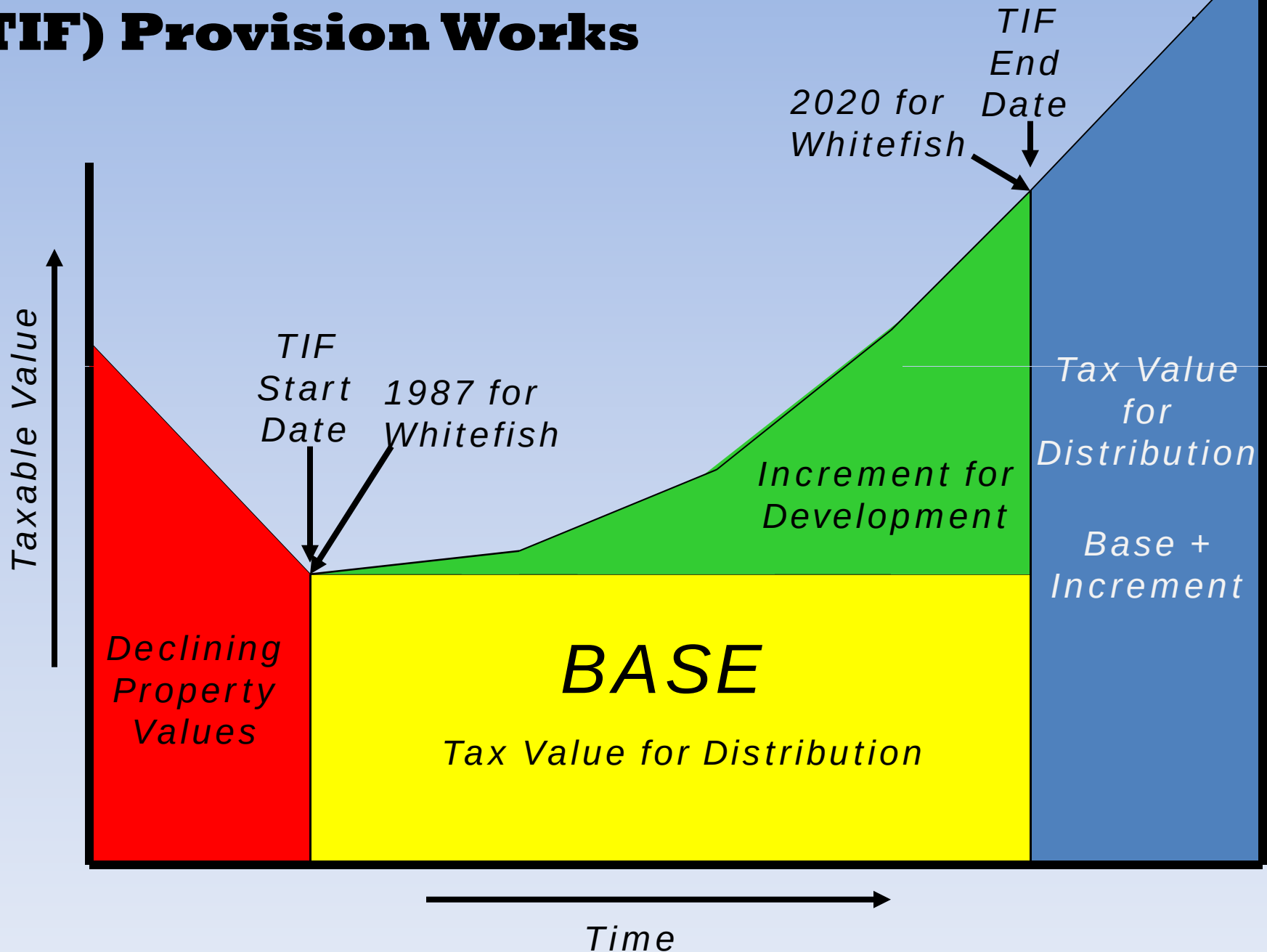
What is Tax Increment Financing? (cont.)



With TIF, the city can do these types of projects:

- Land acquisition
- Demolition and removal of structures
- Relocation
- Planning and analysis
- General redevelopment activities
- Constructing, improving and connecting to infrastructure

How a Tax Increment Finance (TIF) Provision Works



The Tax Increment Calculation



Base Year Value

Taxable Valuation x Mill Levy = Taxes Collected

Directed to all taxing bodies: local governments, schools, state

Tax Increment Value

Incremental Taxable Valuation x Mill Levy = Incremental Taxes Collected

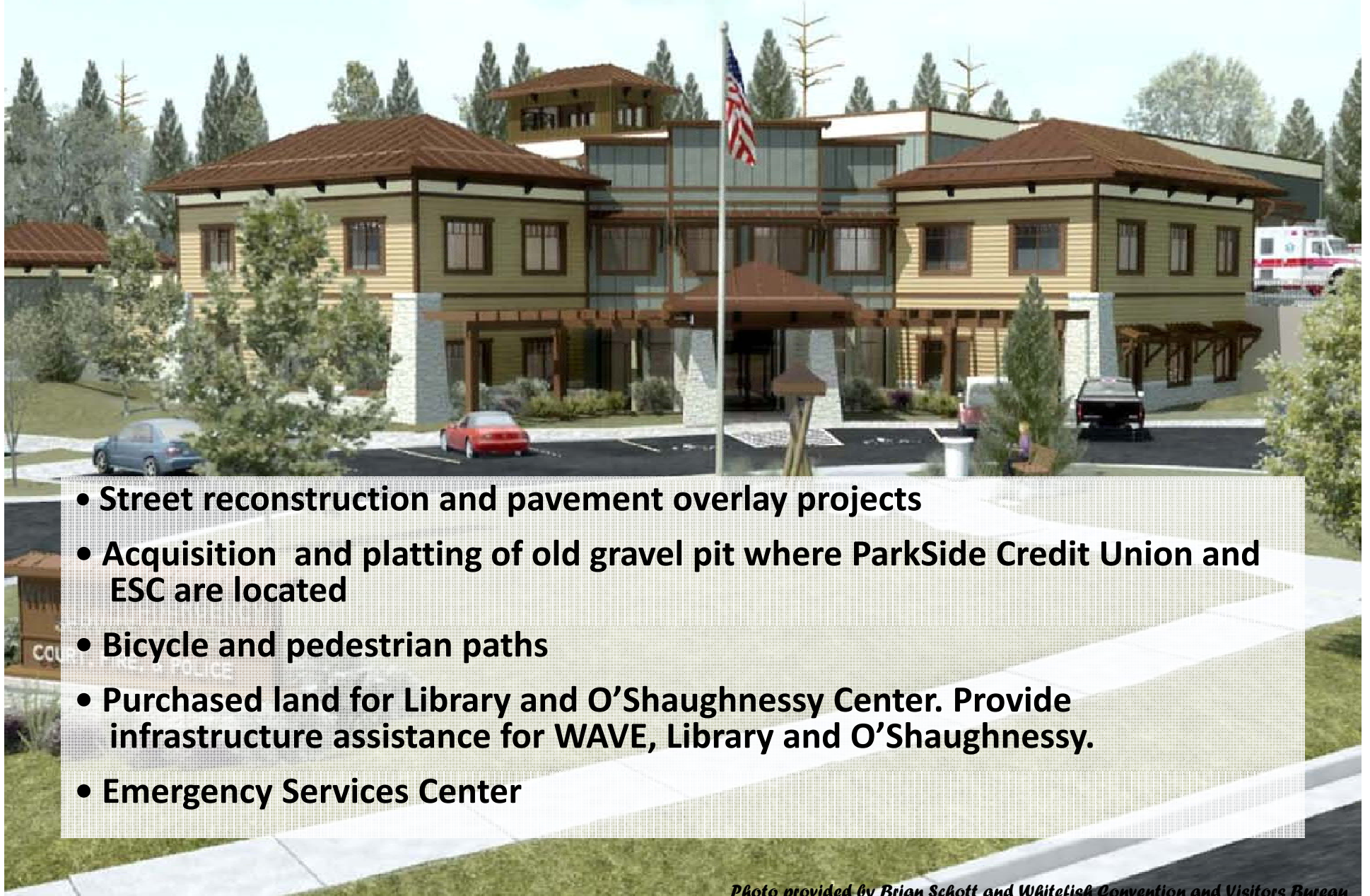
All directed to tax increment program (except university levy) - For FY11, Whitefish increment estimated to be \$3,648,469
